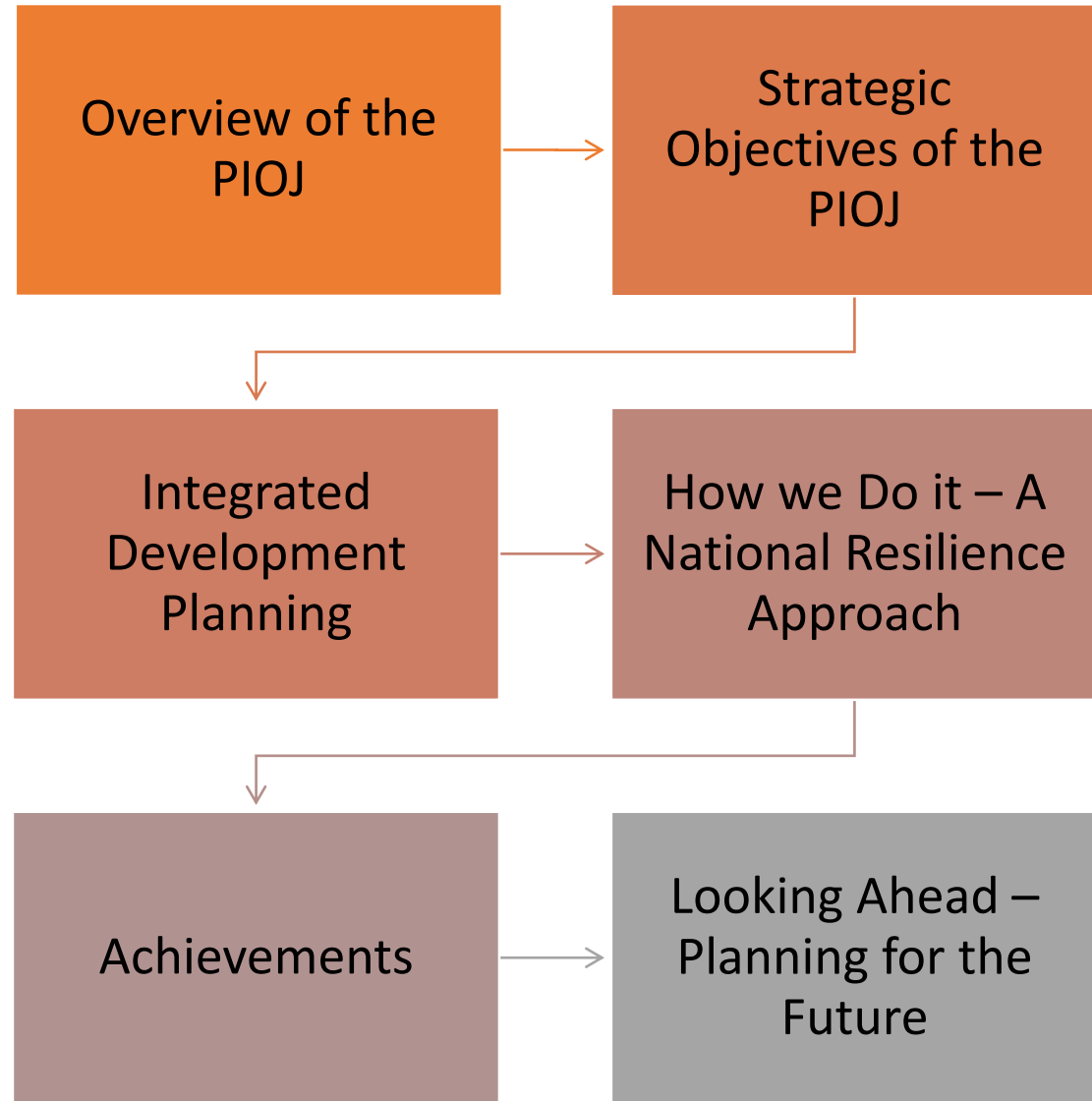

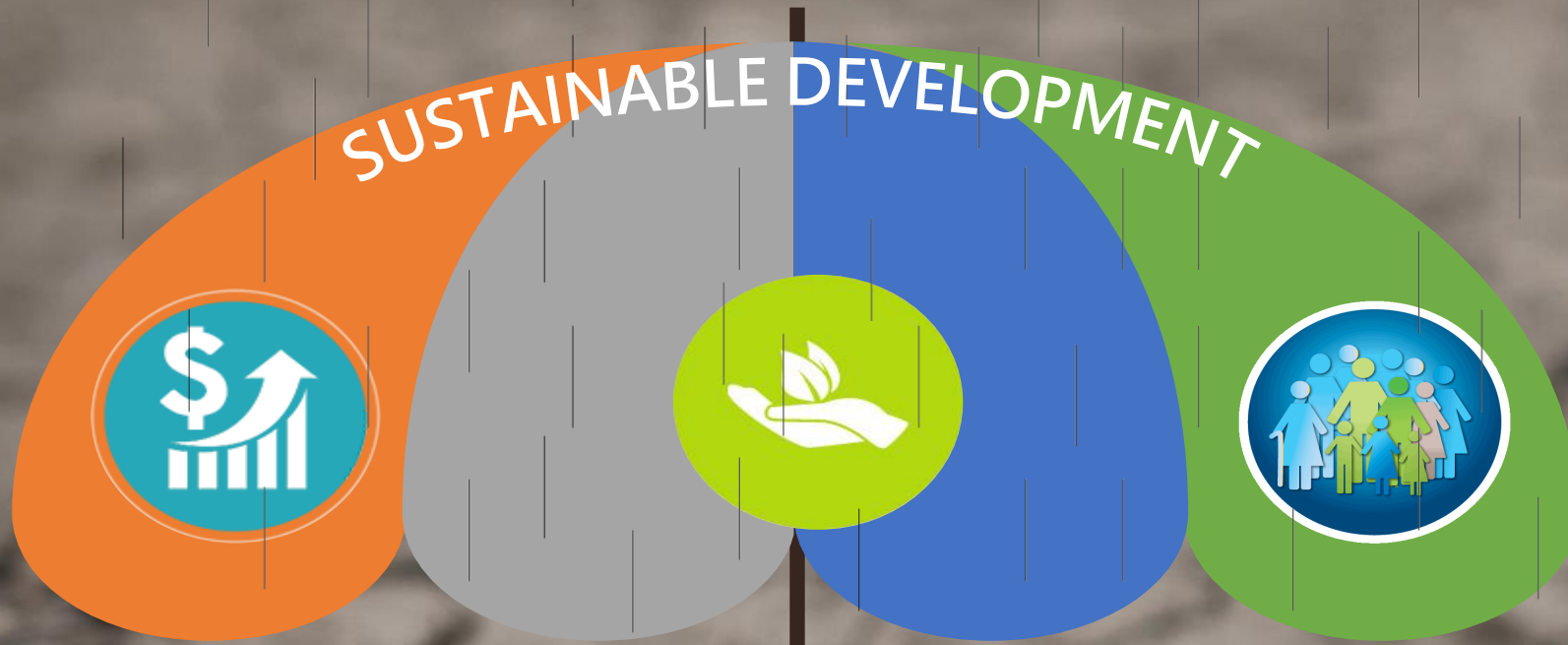
Integrated Development Planning
